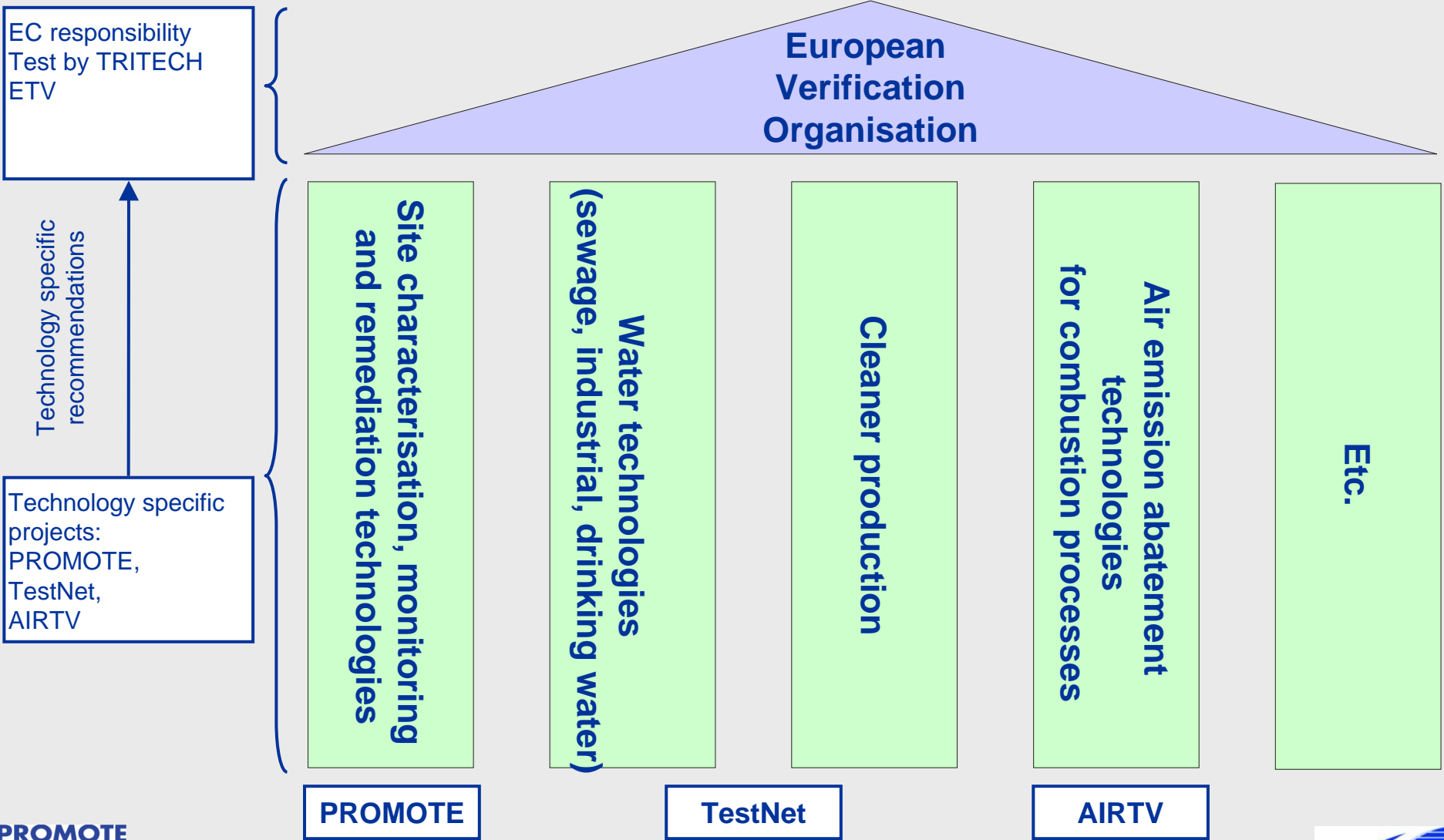

Recommendations -review

- All actions should be aimed at facilitating reaching an affordable, credible and flexible system, avoiding duplication
- Carry out a verification as soon as possible the elements of a draft ETV system with a view to identify gaps, opportunities and impact
- Projects TESTNET and PROMOTE should at least develop one protocol and apply it
- Throughout the process, ensure stakeholder engagement so that test protocols and reporting reflect market realities

Recommendations -review

- Take advantage of certification bodies, which should be correctly accredited
- Identify areas where verified technology would achieve highly positive environmental or public health impact and where there exists immediate motivated vendors, stakeholders and test methods
- Do not spend large amount of efforts on data bases or data base methodology
